INDICATION: Cirrhosis associated with hepatitis C. Failed sustained virologic response.

COMPARISON: 30/10/2018

**FINDINGS:**

Pancreas: Partially obscured by gas.  
Gallbladder: No stones or sludge. Wall thickness normal. Non-tender to probe palpation. CBD: mm, tapering distally.  
Liver: Size 134 mm. Coarse and increased echogenicity consistent with cirrhosis. No focal liver lesion or intrahepatic ductal dilatation.  
Nodular contour. Portal vein 15 mm with hepatopetal flow.  
Aorta: Without aneurysm or dissection.  
Right kidney: Size 124 mm. No cysts. No mass, calculus or hydronephrosis.  
Left kidney: Size 118 mm. No cysts. No mass, calculus or hydronephrosis.  
Spleen: Size 167 mm. Bulky. Homogeneous, without mass or cyst.  
Other: No subhepatic free fluid.
